1 DAY WEST MACDONNELL

RANGES (TJORITJA)

Take an unforgettable journey through the West MacDonnell Ranges, where natural beauty and rich cultural heritage blend effortlessly for an extraordinary experience.

Our adventure begins at Simpsons Gap, a site deeply embedded in Aboriginal culture and Dreamtime stories, featuring a permanent waterhole that attracts various wildlife, including the occasional rock wallaby. Keep your eyes peeled as we explore this sacred site, rich with ancient significance.

- Guided bush walks (= 3-4km)

Next, we head west to Standley Chasm (Angkerle Atwatye, meaning "Gap of Water"), a striking 80-meter-high gorge flanked by towering rock walls that glow in vibrant reds and oranges under the sun.

We then travel to Ellery Creek Big Hole (Udepata), a breathtaking waterhole nestled between red cliffs and sandy creek beds, where you'll have the opportunity to swim in the cool, crystal-clear waters. A delicious picnic lunch will be served, adding to the tranquility of the setting.

We visit the Ochre Pits, a vibrant site with mineral-rich cliffs, displaying stunning colours that offer a glimpse into the area's cultural heritage. Afterward, we head to Orminston Gorge, where you can enjoy a refreshing afternoon swim before heading home.



NT Parks Day Pass Required:

Entry to West MacDonnell National Park is not included in the tour price. Purchase in advance to avoid delays.



- Keep an eye out for the blackfooted rock wallaby and other native wildlife as we explore **Simpsons Gap, or Rungutjirpa**.





WHAT TO BRING

Day Trips: Bring 1L refillable water bottle, sunscreen, sunglasses, wide-brimmed hat, walking shoes, allweather comfortable light clothing, spending money, camera

Multi-Day Tours: Bring 3L of refillable water bottles, all-weather clothing, hiking shoes (closed-toe), wide-brimmed hat, sunscreen, beach & shower towel & toiletries, flashlight, repellent, medication, 15-23kg overnight bag, a small day bag 5-7kg, recharge power bank, and camera.

CHILD POLICY:

Due to the diversity of our product range, our child policy and pricing vary. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult or legal guardian.

LUGGAGE POLICY:

Due to limited vehicle storage in our vehicle and trailer, baggage allowances vary by touring route: **Day Trips:** Bring a small day pack (5-7kg).

Multi-day Tours:

Round-Trip Tours: 1 x 15kg travel bag & 1 x 5kg day bag. Larger bags should be stored at your hotel whilst on tour. One-Way Tours: 1 x 23kg travel bag & 1 x 5kg day bag (different start & finish locations).

The weather in the Red Centre can be extreme, with temperatures exceeding 50°C in the dry season and dropping dramatically at night. Please check the average temperatures for your travel time and pack accordingly. In the event of rain or inclement weather, your experience will proceed unless contacted by the provider.
